The Department of Energy in Fiji, the Pacific Islands Development Forum (PIDF) and the Pacific Center for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency (PCREEE) are happy to announce the convening of the Fiji Sustainable Energy Consortium's (FSEC) Inaugural Annual General Meeting to be held in Suva on 22nd November. This has received wide support following extensive national consultations.

While Fiji's carbon footprint makes up a statistically insignificant 0.006% of global emissions, the Fijian Government and its partners in the non-government sectors are taking bold and ambitious steps to achieve much higher decarbonization ambition in all sectors of the Fijian economy. This national initiative finds political expression through its long-term emissions reductions strategies, known as the Fiji Low Emissions Development Strategy (LEDS).

With the commitments by governments to the Paris Agreements and their associated national energy targets, the need for private sector engagement in creating sustainable business models in the clean energy sector must be emphasized. There is a need for closer collaboration between government, the private sector and NGOs to create an enabling socio-economic environment for business opportunities in the clean energy sector to flourish. Furthermore, there is a need to introduce quality assurance standards in the market to ensure the use of quality products and higher levels of service providers.
